





During the summer break, incoming first graders should read each day. Students should read “on-level” books independently. In addition to independent reading time, parents should read to their child. This allows students to build comprehension, make predictions through questioning, and provides a model of fluency and expression while reading.

Parents are encouraged to help their child keep a record of their summer reading. A Summer Reading Log is attached. Please print the log and list books by writing the title and author. Students should bring their list on the first day of school and will be recognized for their summer reading accountability.
