

The 2006 B.A. Scorpions Football season was one to remember. Both the JV and Varsity teams had 8-1 records with the Varsity team coming in 2nd in the league and JV finishing 3rd.

For Varsity, the regular season was a perfect 6-0, with Zack Barker leading at QB. An early season win over FISH 26-6 set the stage for two of the toughest games of the year, a 14-7 win over Central Baptist and a 12-7 win over Bell Shoals. In both games, Barker and Nasser Musa played huge roles. Musa had a key INT late vs. Bell Shoals to seal the win. An 18-0 shutout of COR and a 18-0 win over ILS led to the final regular season game of the year. In a hard fought battle, a late option keeper by Barker led to a Chris Conradi TD run to pull out a 12-6 win and finish the regular season 6-0. The tremendous fake option was the play of the year.

In the playoffs, big plays by Danny Nixon, Nick Jefferson and Bryce Montane got BA through the first round vs. COR 14-6. In the semi-final game, Barker threw 3 TD's to Musa and Jefferson with extra points by Conradi and Barker to secure the 14-12 win over Bell Shoals and send the Scorpions into the Championship game.

In a showdown for the ages, two undefeated teams clashed when BA met Florida College for the title. Barker, injured in the semi final game was replaced by backup QB Danny Nixon, who threw 3 TD's. Tied 19-19 with only minutes left, Florida College completed a long TD pass to win 25-19. This is still remembered as one of the greatest games BA has ever played.

On the JV side, BA also has tremendous success. JV got off to a strong start with wins over FISH and Central Baptist in which QB Noah Shaffer threw 6 TD's and ran for 2. a 19-0 win over Bell Shoals and a tough 12-7 win over COR had the Scorpions on a roll. In the COR game, botched punt gave BA the ball on the COR 18 yard line and was the play of the year. Shutout wins over ILS 31-0 and Family of Christ 19-0 had BA ready for playoff action.

In the first round of the playoffs, BA shut out FISH 18-0 with Shaffer, Tyler Boane and Michael McGuire leading the scoring. In the semi-final game, BA ran into Seffner Christian and lost a hard fought 13-7 battle. In the 3rd place game, BA dominated Bell Shoals for the second time during the season winning 27-12 and taking home 3rd place in the league. The JV Scorpions finished the season with 179 points for and only 32 against.
