Dear BA Parents, Colleagues and Students,

Scorpion Scoop readers may be interested to learn that a recent study from the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS), took as its primary goal the identification and description of the characteristics of high-quality teachers in independent schools. What makes a great teacher? The findings quite clearly showed the following: high-quality independent school teachers: 1) develop trusting and meaningful relationships with students; 2) demonstrate strong pedagogical knowledge and content expertise; 3) possess an ability to continually grow and learn as professional teachers as well as model learners; and; 4) are authentically committed to and ingrained in the school culture and mission.

Furthermore the research showed that independent schools not only value a teacher's ability to develop meaningful relationships with students and possess strong pedagogical and content knowledge, but they also value his or her application of those core competencies of teaching and learning. In other words, schools strive to ensure that a teacher's pedagogical and content-area skill and knowledge fit perfectly and positively within the context and culture of their particular school community. Teachers who know their subject, enjoy their students and appreciate and value their school, are always going to perform better as professionals and achieve greater success for their students.

I have to say that, based on my first couple of weeks at Brandon Academy, I have every confidence that our amazing teaching team here at BA is meeting and exceeding all of these criteria and more. We have made an excellent start to the year.
