

DESCRIPTION OF EXTRA-CURRICULARS

JUNIOR SHOW CHOIR –(2nd-5th grades) We will learn the basic techniques of singing and performing. On occasion this group will accompany our “Show Choir” for some shows in the community, as well as perform for the school. Please note that this activity, which meets on ***Thursdays*** from 3:30-4:30 beginning September 8th, will also take commitment on the part of the parents as some performances may occur after school hours. There is a REQUIRED performance outfit.

MUSIC AND MOVEMENT– (PreK3-JK) Children will have the opportunity to explore different types of music and gross motor skills. The activity will take place in the PREK/JK building and is sponsored by Mrs. Gaines and Mrs. Huebner. It will meet on the last Wednesday of each month beginning September 28 – April 26th from 3:30 – 4:00. Limited to 15 students and a fee of \$5 cash only please) for supplies will be collected.

GERMAN CLUB-(3RD-8TH) Learn German vocabulary, games, and culture. Viel Spass!!! Mrs. V will meet in her classroom every Wednesday from 3:45-4:15 starting Sept. 28th - April 19th. A fee of \$10 will be collected

INNOVATION LAB-(4TH-6TH GRADES Students will explore the joy and excitement of Disassembling different objects, appliances, electronics, etc to discover the "nuts and Bolts" of the object.
