The following are club choices for the Upper Division for 2019/2020.

Key Club - this a student-led organization that provides its members with opportunities to perform service, build character and develop leadership. **NOTE:** this club is limited to 9-12 grades only.

Cosmetology Club - this club will teach proper nail hygiene and techniques with gel polish and stamping. *NOTE: this club is limited to 9-12 grades only.*

BA Beautification Club - this club will design and carry out projects to add and maintain the beauty of our campus. This could include weeding and watering plants, clearing our rock path and designing/carrying out new ideas to make BA beautiful.

Art from the Heart Club - this club will create inspirational art pieces while having the opportunity to create works for auctions and as donations to food banks and animal shelters in the Tampa Bay area.

Movies - this club will enjoy different genres of movies from current to classics. *This club is limited to 6 to 8 grades only.*

Reading/Book Club - this club will allow students to read and discuss interesting books of their choice within the group. Books will be screened for appropriateness.

Board Games - in this club students will bring in board games **NOT** electronic games - chess, monopoly, etc. This club will also do a service project for the holidays. *This* club is limited to grades 6-8.

Introduction to meditation and mindfulness - in this club, students will learn basic strategies for stress management and reduction, how to calm their minds and deal better with distressing and overwhelming emotions and thoughts. It will talk about the background of mediation used by Buddhists.

Math Counts - this club is a program designed to make learning math fun. The program builds problem solving skills and creative thinking so that students will embrace challenges throughout their academic career. There are local and regional competitions that students will have the opportunity to participate in area competitions. **There is a small fee for students who wish to be on the competing team.**

Student Council - this club is designed for students who are elected by the student body. There are five positions elected by the upper division: President & Vice President (9-12 grade only) and Secretary, Treasurer and Community Service Officer (6-8 grade only). In addition, there will be two reps from each grade level. The student council will organize events such as the Haunted House, Dances, Spirit Week, etc. *NOTE: this club will meet more than once a month during lunch/recess.*
