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Message from new Tech Teacher

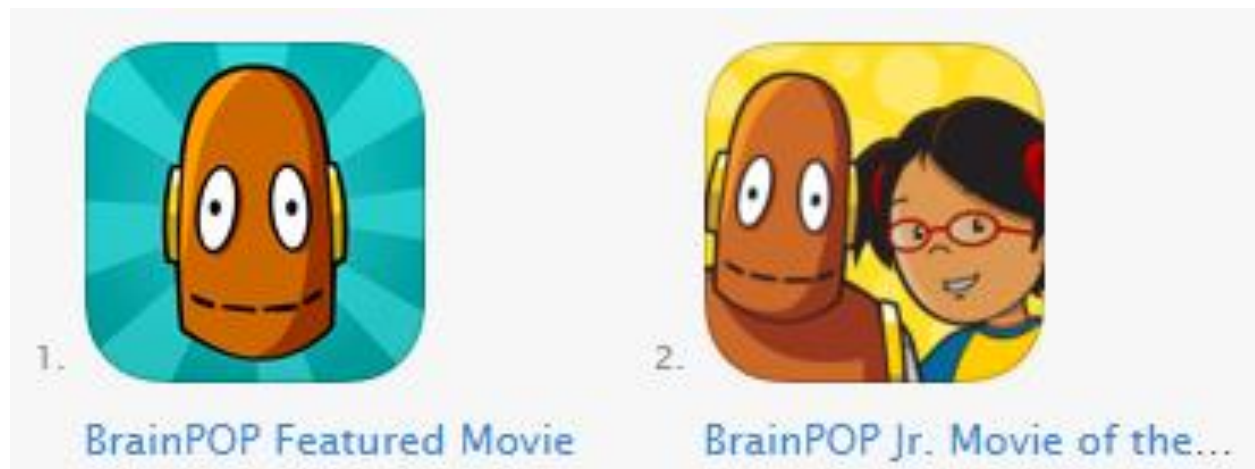

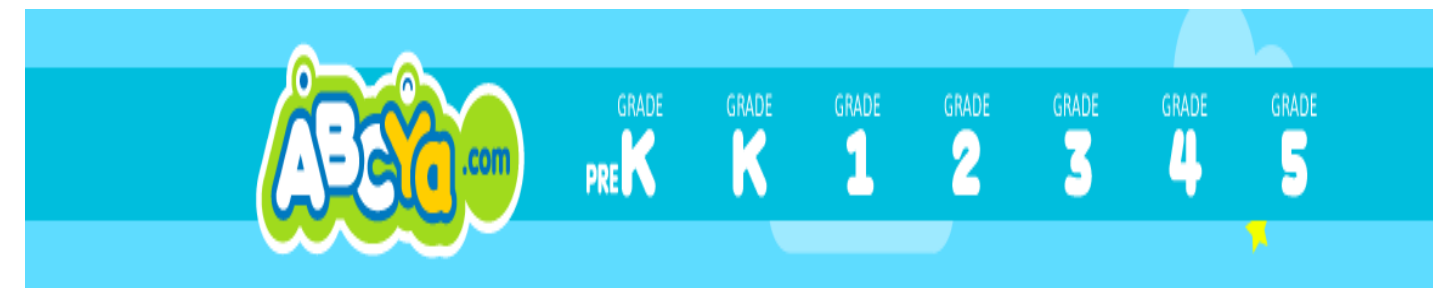

Recommended Free PC Website



The non-advertisement version of ABCYA.com runs \$7.99/month. But the free version albeit with ads is tolerable. There is a variety of games such as Keyboard Zoo (never too early to expose the youngest ones to letter recognition and keyboard placement) to introductory coding in Lightbot. Please note: many of these games require Flash or Shockwave player and thus will not work on iPads, iPhones and many Android products.
